Julian welcomed all attendees, starting by sharing apologies and notifying Board members that Chris Jones and Richard Edwards have recently been appointed to the Board. Group Captain Mark Lorriman-Hughes welcomed Board members and guests to RAF Waddington

Greater Lincolnshire Defence & Security Network Inaugural Dinner - Feedback

Positive feedback received from those who attended the dinner, complimenting the venue location, speakers and the beneficial networking opportunities which the dinner offered. Positive conversations have taken place during and after the dinner with Jas Shanker and Jim Pennycook from DASA who both support what we are trying to achieve.

Board member Chris Jones gave feedback on the RDSC update to the Leonardo/EWS local defence industry networking event on 5th May, focusing on the 3 key points of a September launch, a membership organisation structure, and currently gathering interest from local industry. This was well received, with lots of support for formalising the GL Defence and Security Network.

45 people in attendance to the second event in their programme. Chris was able to signpost those interested in the network to Jas Shanker who was in attendance to discuss the benefits of joining the network. Follow up questions were regarding sustaining the network beyond the ideas of innovation and how we put those ideas into production. All attendees were in support of the network and there was a clear understanding of the purpose and benefits of the network.

Defence and Security Network and Regional Defence & Security Cluster update

Led by Julian Free, presenting the below focus regarding the launch and creation of the Lincolnshire Regional Defence & Security Cluster (RDSC) in partnership with DASA.

RDSC Requirements

- Clear support must be shown from local industry for the network, however more contacts need to be given from Board members in order for further promotion and evidencing support and attendance for events
- Governance structure must be finalised

<u>RDSC Governance</u> Update delivered by Alison Ballard

• Purpose and benefits for partners must be more explicit. New wording suggested.

Our aim is to bring more defence and security investment into the region. There are benefits of this aggregation to all. For SMEs, looking for a route to market, they have local access to prime defence contractors. They in turn get visibility of new and emerging technology they may wish to acquire. UKG and its executive agencies can set challenges or funding rounds targeted at this part of the sector.

- Feedback received from Board members.
- Need the ability to commercialise solutions to defence and security challenges.

- MOD do not necessarily want to have large numbers of SMEs on their books hence the clustering to try and get the RDSCs to be DASA forward to link the SME innovators into larger defence contractors.
- Highlighting opportunities for innovation funding and signposting to DASA and other research and development funding organisations.
- Sub-set of funding available for the Defence sector may be available through the GL LEP for the network.
- KPI to measure inward investment for the defence sector may prove difficult therefore wording of targets to needs to be managed.
- Do we need more focus on the security part of the network? Are we appropriately represented on the Board and within the network from a security perspective?
- 3 Counties RDSC fee is £199+ vat to join the network, which is currently utilised to fund event stalls
 between 60-70 members currently part of their network,
- Financial business plan needed in order to decipher how membership fee is utilised. Membership joining fee was agreed as £200, which can be reviewed.
- Budget available for part time post initially to assist with administrative duties, business case creation and potential website creation/management.
- Initial budget £40k. Expense to date: Board Dinner, DSEI pitch, stand design and build.
- Budget remaining c£23-24k Outstanding task is to produce a full budget and business case.

Defence Sector Proposition

Update delivered by Karen Seal

The Defence Sector Proposition (Version 4) was circulated to Board members prior to the meeting taking place.

Discussion took place regarding more images being needed for the proposition print, ideally images that are going to attract potential partners and positively shine a light on the current technology being developed within the county.

Rationale needed to display particular logos, to which companies need to be approached in order for logo permission to be granted.

Predominantly digital copy will be created in order to cater for updating purposes, however a short print run will be undertaken as well.
